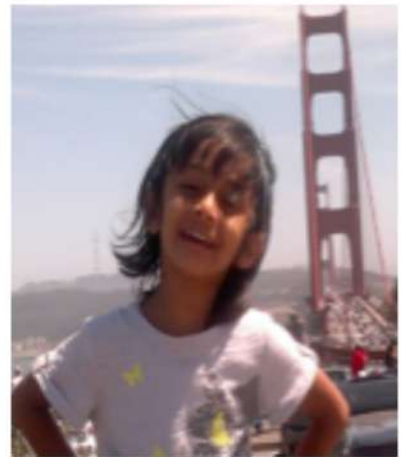


Children's day

“There is no garden as beautiful as childhood”.

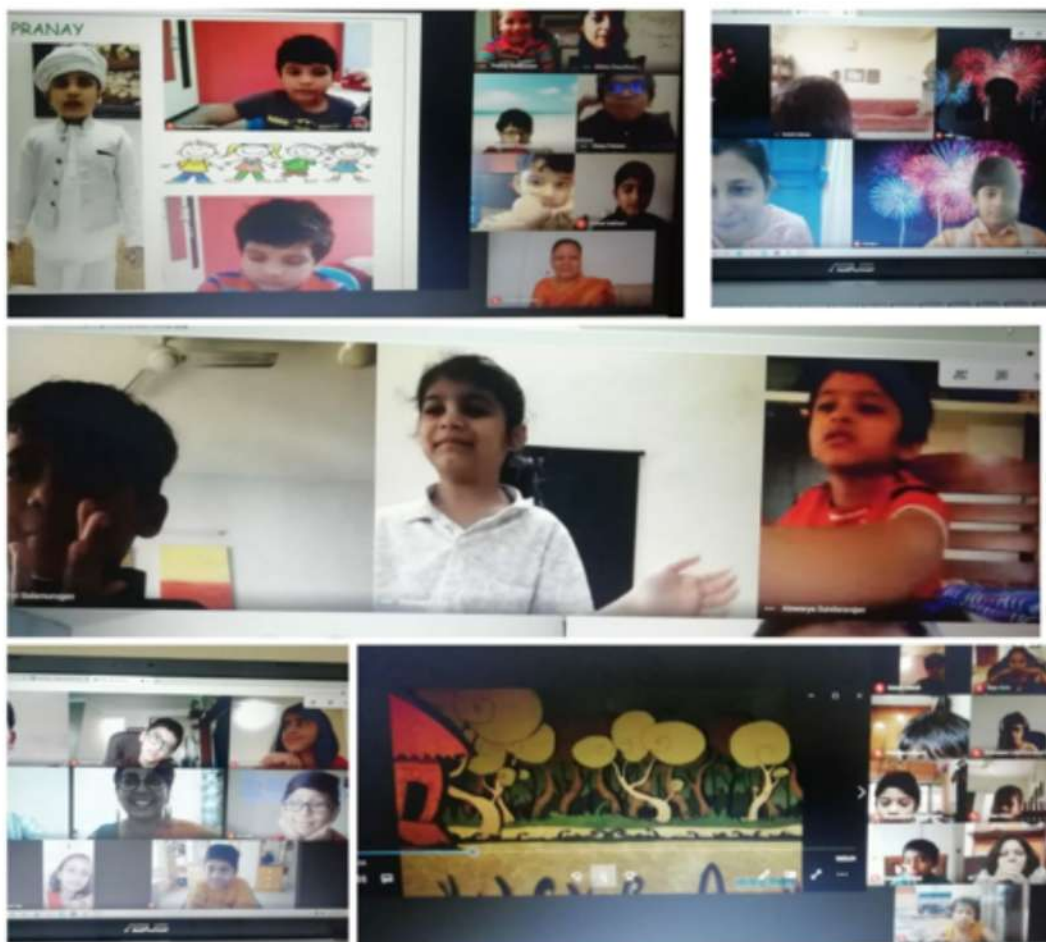

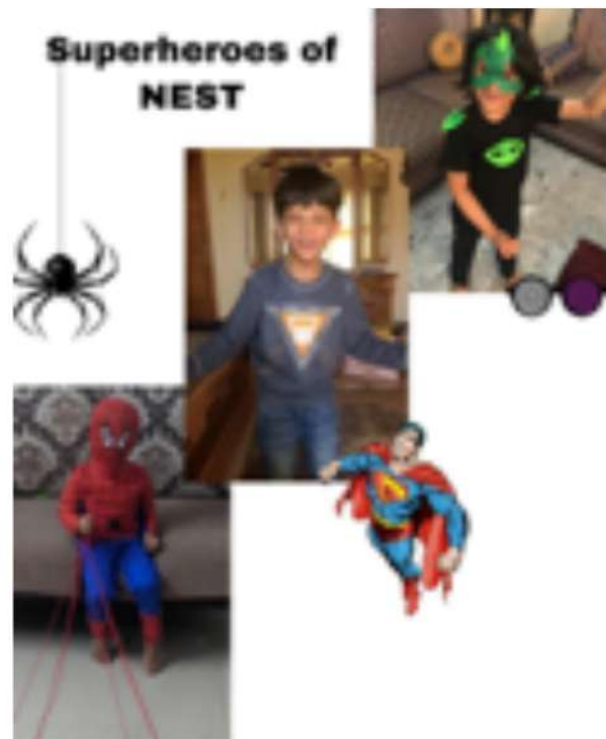
